Lesson Policies

- **STUDENT AGE & READINESS LEVEL:** In general, first grade or later is a wonderful time for most children to start taking piano lessons. For students younger than first grade, please contact me to discuss the curriculum, teaching approach and individual student readiness. (I use a separate curriculum with preschool students.) I also welcome older beginners and adult students.
- **LESSON LENGTH:** Lessons are usually weekly and one-half hour in length, although longer lesson times may be available for older or intermediate-level students. Please check with me for availability if you are interested.
- **PRACTICE POLICY:** Regular practice is critical for progress to be made. Students are expected to practice regularly (at least 5 days a week). Suggested practice times are as follows: 10-15 minutes per day for early beginning-level students, 20-30 minutes per day for later beginning-level students, 30 minutes per day for intermediate students and 45 minutes or more per day for advanced students. Students will be required to keep track of weekly practice, and those who fail to practice regularly may be let go from my studio.
- **PERFORMANCE PHILOSOPHY:** Performance is strongly encouraged, but is not a required part of the lesson experience. Students will have the opportunity to participate in a spring recital. Other performance opportunities will also be available throughout the year.
- **MATERIALS:** Students may be loaned music or flashcards from my personal music library. It is assumed that these items will be treated with proper care. Students are responsible for paying the replacement cost of lost materials or those damaged beyond repair.
- **PAYMENT METHOD:** Payment is due at the start of each trimester (See dates below). Payment should be in the form of cash or a check made out to **Jennifer's Piano Studio LLC**.
- **TUITION RATES: Tuition is billed on a trimester basis (September-November/ December-February/March-May):**
 - Weekly 30 minute lessons will be billed at a rate of \$225/trimester.
 - A family discount of 5% will be applied for each additional student within the same family who enrolls in weekly lessons.
 - Each trimester will have 12 lesson opportunities. **Tuition is due no later than the first lesson date of each trimester: September 4** for the fall trimester, **December 4** for the winter trimester and **March 19** for the spring trimester. *Tuition covers not only the lesson time itself, but also costs such as studio maintenance and expenses, lesson preparation, and my time spent purchasing books/materials and in communication with students and parents. It does not cover the cost of student lesson books, although some supplementary books/supplies may be borrowed from my studio library.

- **CALENDAR DETAILS:**

There will be no lessons on Tuesday, December 25 (Christmas) or January 1 (New Year's).

Makeup lessons will be offered on the following dates (no regularly scheduled lessons):

- Tuesday, November 27 (Open Makeup Lesson Day)
- Tuesday, March 12 (Open Makeup Lesson Day)
- Tuesday, June 11 (Open Makeup Lesson Day)

- **CANCELLATION POLICY:** Please notify me in advance if you are ever unable to make your lesson time. Cancellations may be made by email at jzuhlke@gmail.com or by phone/text at 608-698-7390. There is no refund given for a missed lesson.

- **RESCHEDULING POLICIES:**

- Please make every effort to attend your scheduled lesson or make use of the "Swap" List (see below). As I will be unable to offer makeup lessons when I do not have child care available, rescheduling outside of a designated "Makeup Lesson Day" will not be possible. (See note below for more information.)
- **Open Makeup Lesson Days:** These are open dates on which no regular lessons will be scheduled. However, if you miss a lesson you may request a makeup lesson on one of these dates. See "Calendar Details" above for these dates.
- If I need to cancel a lesson I will make every attempt to reschedule it or you will be given a full refund for the lesson.

- **"SWAP" LIST:** This is a list of students who are willing to consider a lesson time "swap", should you ever need to reschedule. If a scheduling conflict comes up with your lesson time, you are welcome to contact any family/student on the list to see if they are willing to switch lesson times with you that week. You may also "double up" for a longer lesson, by offering your lesson time in any given week to the student before/after you, and then using their time the following week. Being on the list does not obligate you to swap with another family, but it does let them know that you would consider a one-time switch if it fits your schedule. Please let me know if you would like to be included on the "Swap" list or would like more information about it.
